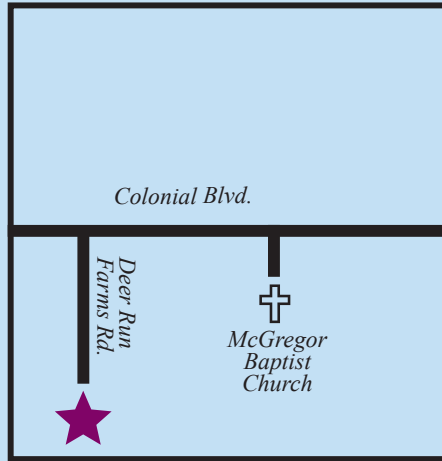

What is the Access Center?

The Access Center provides mental health assessments and referral services for adults and children who are not in immediate crisis, but are seeking services at Lee Mental Health Center. Services for which you may be eligible include mental health assessments, substance abuse outpatient counseling, case management and in-home therapeutic services for children and adults, diversion services, supported employment and medication management. Those requiring residential treatment may also be eligible for the DATE Program (Drug Abuse Treatment & Education).

What is expected of me?

You will be expected to provide information regarding your current circumstances, the names and addresses of previous providers, medications you may be taking and the doctors prescribing the medications. You will be asked for your date of birth, current address and working telephone number, next of kin and financial information.

How much does it cost?

There is no cost for the initial screening or for the intake assessment. Additional assessments may be billed to your insurance company or you may be responsible to pay for the additional services. Lee Mental Health Center is a Medicaid and Medicare provider. Some Center programs are offered utilizing the State recommended sliding fee scale. Each individual presenting for services may speak with the Financial Counselor to discuss payment and costs of services.
